WHO?

- Any alumnae member of Sigma Kappa is eligible to serve as a member of a corporation board or property committee
- Look for women with a background in accounting/finance, decorating, construction, project management, etc.
- Don't eliminate potential members because they don't have the background you are looking for. Many women have hidden talents/gifts that can be helpful to a CB or PC.



WHAT?

- If you have a house or situation that is difficult to begin with, do as much as you can to clean it up before you try to recruit members for the CB or PC. It is much easier to recruit people in to an organized situation rather than a chaotic one.



WHEN?

- Recruit new members whenever there are openings based on your bylaws. Most bylaws require 3-7 members of the CB or PC.
- Recruit new members when current members are ready to retire or take a less active role on the board.
- Recruit new members when it is obvious that only one or two of the current members are doing all of the work.



WHERE?

- Attend local alumnae chapter meetings and announce openings on the CB or PC.
- Advertise in chapter alumnae newsletters
- Attend chapter Founder's Day celebrations, Homecoming events, chapter recruitment and other on-campus events where alumnae are invited.
- Announce openings at the annual meeting.
- Social networking sites are a good place to find alumnae.



HOW?

- Think about how you were recruited. Who contacted you and what did they say to make you want to join?
- Personal contact works best. It's much harder for someone to say no face to face or on the phone.
- Contact the Advisory Board and/or the CPO for potential names .
- Have a job description ready to share.
- Offer a short-term position on a committee to introduce the board to a potential member and the potential member to the board responsibilities.
